B. Policy for Recommending a SOPHOMORE Student for AP LANGUAGE:

[pre-optioning]

- a. student must have an overall B average in their English courses at WHHS
- b. student from English 10 must have at least an A average in English for the (current) first semester, with no Cs; student from English 10AA must have at least a B average for the first semester, with no Cs
- c. student must be on approval list for advanced courses (submitted to administrator)
- d. student must receive a recommendation from his/her current English teacher
- e. student must fill out an application and turn it in by established due date

[post-optioning: same year, second semester]

- f. student must maintain an A average in English for the second semester
- g. student must submit writing sample to AP Language teacher for approval
- h. student who was recommended for the AP Language course, but fails to maintain a B average second semester will *forfeit* his/her opportunity for the AP course (current teacher will notify administrator and student at end of second semester of this change)
- i. student must sign off on summer work, thus agreeing to complete all summer work
- j. student who *did not meet recommendation criteria* <u>prior</u> to optioning can earn a recommendation by the end of second semester if:
 - 1. student informs the teacher of his/her interest
 - 2. both parties agree that if the student shows significant growth {see **e**, **f** and **h**} in grades and/or attitude during second semester then the student will be allowed to sign up for the course
 - 3. student may need to produce writing sample for approval
 - 4. teacher informs counselor and student at the end of the semester of this change

[post-optioning: following year in the AP course]

- k. student who fails to complete summer work will forfeit grade protection and will receive grade earned first quarter
- I. student who fails to maintain a B average for the entire first semester *could* "lose status" though remain in the class for the duration of the year, thus forfeiting the option to move to an advanced course the next year—unless meets criteria in *f*
