- Call to order
- Approval of Prior Meeting's Minutes:
 - Motion to accept John Chambers, seconded by Ashley Morgan
- Principal's report
 - We've had multiple activities take place in the building
 - Academic Quiz Team met for an in-house competition, which was nice to see
 - Finishing up textbook and supply distribution for the second semester this week
 - One more test session:
 - 175 kids test, no scores yet
 - The number of kids bringing in for testing is a little lighter to allow for social distancing
 - Added three additional test dates through March and April
 - To allow for students taking the test for the first time and those that will retake the exam
 - We have lost a total of 64 students since the beginning of the year

- Logistics:

- We have 4 temperature machines (students will need to go through both the temp check machines and through the metal detectors to enter the building)
- 7th graders never in the building before? Parent concern
- Quality of instruction and concerns with what the students will learn with the blended model? Parent concern
- Far less instruction time, plus to have kids in the building, but there will be less instruction due to A/B schedule: Monday will be remote (A and B), in-person Group A (T/W) or Group B (Th/F), and asynchronous on Group A (Th/F) or Group B (T/W)
- Student Congress President, Student Body will be drafting a letter and sending it to the Board; also a survey has been going out and results will be shared at the Board meeting
- 8th grade students taking highschool classes, if 9-12 begins on February 15 and 7-8 begin on March 1, students will miss out on instruction for those two weeks
- Possibility of bringing everyone in on March 1 (7-12) will allow for 7th graders to have an opportunity to get in for an orientation to familiarize themselves with the building
- Originally mandatory 6ft. social distancing, but lowered to 3ft. to accommodate a Walnut return
