
Teacher Recommendations


- ➤ Ask early in a face-to-face meeting
- > Provide teachers with written information:
 - ➤ Where you are applying/deadlines
 - > Academic and career goals
 - ➤ Provide examples of your best work (paper, experiment, creative assignment) from that class
 - ➤ If applicable, include your favorite topic from that class with an explanation of why!
- ➤ Write thank-you notes and let recommenders know where you will be attending

Helping Recommenders

- ➤ Meet with your teachers to ask if they will recommend you
- >Then, add teachers in Naviance
- For each teacher, specify the colleges along with deadlines where he or she should send the recommendations







Testing

- > ACT or SAT?
- Some schools are "test optional"
- Some require "subject area" tests (SAT Subject Tests)
- ➤ YOU must order official score reports for each school (4-6 weeks in advance of deadline)
- May send scores to 4 colleges as part of the testing fee, up to 5 days (ACT) or 9 days (SAT) after test date
- ➤ If you send ACT scores later, cost is \$13.00 per test date per college.
- ➤ If you send SAT scores later, cost is \$12.00 per college. Any or all scores can be sent to a college in a single report.

The Essay

OWN YOUR OWN STORY

Share a story that is uniquely yours, one that no one else could tell

Fundamental Principle

Pretentious, inauthentic voice that comes from trying to impress the admissions officers

➤ Overused topics and trite, overstated reflections

Definitely avoid!

Write with <u>detail and description</u> – add enough detail that you tell a story that no one else could tell

Write in a <u>real, honest voice</u> – sound like you. Let your personality shine through the essay.

Definitely do!

- Finalize college list
- ➤ Make applications
- ➤ Order official test scores
- > Invite teacher recommenders
- ➤ Choose decision plan(s)
- > Seek out application/scholarship resources now!
